

Vistage Chair News and Updates These Chairs Have 'Mastered' Their Roles



(March 12, 2008) Two years ago Vistage added a special designation for Chair Excellence Award recipients who accomplished results well beyond chosen criteria. This past weekend, 26 individuals were honored for their outstanding efforts during the past year.

To be named a Master Chair, Chairs had to accomplish the following over the 12 calendar months:

- Average 14+ members per group with no carries
- Average 85 percent retention in CE programs and 80 percent retention in SB programs
- Average 14+ members in a Key group or, if the Chair did not have a Key group, 45% of the Chair's CE members must sponsor at least one Key member in another Chair's Key group
- Chair at least 60 meetings
- Be in compliance with brand standards, including the Chair's Web site, signature, marketing collateral.

"Our Master Chairs truly have gone above and beyond to meet the needs of our community and the Vistage organization," noted Greg Wells, Chief of Field Operations. "Their efforts are remarkable and we're delighted to honor each with this distinction."
